PLUMISMO, for piccolo flute solo.

Everything sounds an octave higher.

6.- Only frulatti.

7.- The gesture of inhaling air should be exaggerated.

8.- As in 1.

9.- With the "F" sound the air is inhaled through the flute.

10.- Only frulatti.

Other indications are:

(k) means the "K" sound produced by the throat to enhance the attack.

The U signs mean the inclination of the flute in relation to the mouth of the player.

♩ and ♪ mean between ♭ and ♯ and between ♮ and ♯ respectively.

↗ "Bending" in the direction that it shows.

♩ frulatti.

"Whistle", a very soft harmonic that sounds like a quiet whistle.

♩ "s" sound only, with frulatti, no pitch.

4.- On the B natural (where the * is placed), the flutist should kiss the embouchure, producing a high and resonant sound with some B intonation.

5.- Same note position but pronouncing the letter "F".

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
